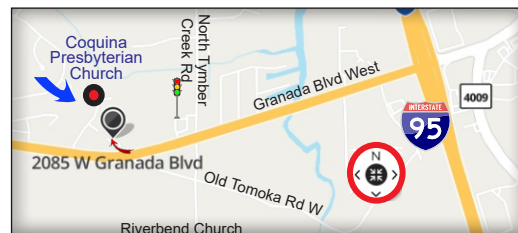

The Bright Report

Should Our Elected Officials Decide the Question When They Deem the Issue “Too Complex” for the Voters?



Ormond Beach is confronted with a challenging decision — should the direction of future potable reuse (Toilet-to-Tap) projects be determined by elected officials, or should it be left up to the voters? The debate exposes tensions between representative governance and direct democracy, especially when officials consider excluding topics from ballots as “too complex” for public decision-making.

Short answer NO—elected officials should not categorically decide to remove issues from voters simply because they deem them “too complex.” They should use representative tools (expert review, deliberation, and policymaking) while ensuring informed public participation and, when appropriate, offering voters a clear, well-framed choice.

Voters have the right to decide major policy directions that affect public health, land use, and long-term community character. Automatically excluding them risks eroding trust and shifts important value judgments away from public accountability. Complexity doesn't justify exclusion; it requires better processes: expert briefs, transparent risk assessments, plain-language summaries, public forums, and deliberative tools.

Labeling an issue “too complex” can be used selectively to block democratic accountability or to shield political decisions from scrutiny. That risk argues for standardized, transparent criteria before removing topics from ballots. A charter amendment would lock in voter consent, preventing future councils or developers from moving forward without direct approval. The restriction is also a brake on growth, an instrument to limit new development that might strain local water resources.

Utilities, industry experts, and some commissioners—counter with “science.” Potable reuse (Toilet-to-Tap) relies on multiple treatment barriers and rigorous monitoring, they say, and can be a safe, cost-effective tool for long-term resilience. City staff note Ormond Beach presently has adequate water supplies and no immediate plans for potable reuse; but a ban now could remove the option for future use.

Procedural concerns complicate the decision. Some on the Dias favor a binding charter amendment, while others prefer a deliberative path: staff studies, and public (re)education. Ormond Beach could (a) place a binding charter amendment on the ballot, (b) order public (re)education, or (c) decline action and rely on staff planning.

At stake is more than potable reuse (Toilet-to-Tap): The Ormond Beach debate reflects a broader democratic question—who should make complex technical policy choices when values, science, and future risks collide? How commissioners proceed will determine enshrining the community's trust in democratic processes.

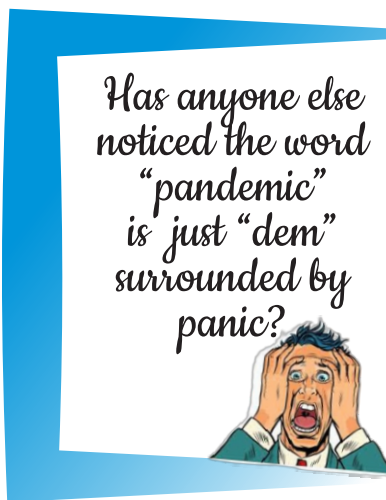

How to Get the SAVE America Act Over the Finish Line It can be done if Republicans have the political courage to listen to almost 80% of American voters.

The Founding Fathers distrusted democracy and abhorred direct elections. Instead, they gave us a republic in which the president is chosen by the Electoral College and senators by state legislatures. If they could see their republic today, and what now passes for elections, they'd be appalled.

Any mention of mail-in ballots, ballot harvesting, election "season," drop boxes, ballot curing, and gerrymandering would have stopped the Constitutional Convention cold. The massive election fraud—I mean, "irregularities"—of the 2020 election made it unmistakably clear that if the country is not to be torn in two, election reform is imperative.

Rarely has this fractured country been more united on this fact. 80% of Americans support requiring that people present a photo ID to vote; 83% support requiring proof of citizenship to register; and three times as many voters believe there's "a lot" of voter fraud in mail-ins compared to in-person voting (38% vs 13%).

But just like switching the clocks twice a year—approved by just 12% of Americans—somehow, nothing changes. The Deep State is not interested in what Americans want and never has been.

Trump, however, is interested in the average American. He killed off DEI, is keeping men out of your daughter's sports and locker rooms, has secured the border, and is fighting crime—policies that are universally supported, whether openly or secretly, by all but the psychotic left. He understands that if we can't ensure fair elections whose results are believed by both sides, the country is finished. And despite obstacles at every turn, Trump remains relentless.

Posting on Truth Social, Trump announced he's going "to get rid of MAIL-IN BALLOTS" and instead use "watermark paper" ballots, "which is faster, and leaves NO DOUBT as to who WON." He followed that with an even more defiant post: "There will be Voter I.D. for the Midterm Elections, whether approved by Congress or not!"

You must admire that tenacity. But tenacity is no match for federal judges, RINOs, the Senate filibuster, and the Constitution—the last named of which makes clear that the Executive Branch has no power over elections as "the times, places and manner of holding elections...shall be prescribed in each state by the Legislature thereof."

The only exception, thankfully, is that "Congress may at any time by law make or alter such regulations." Bluster and rhetoric are useless here. It is only through this clause that Trump can save the Republic, but with a recalcitrant Congress, how?

Here's the plan, which isn't easy, but is doable.

First, Thune has to go. Never before in the history of the Senate has a majority leader of the president's own party kept the Senate in session to prevent recess appointments, and he has refused even to bring the SAVE America Act up for debate. He's arguably the worst possible choice Republicans could have made.

Unseating Thune won't be easy, but with the enormous power Trump has, which couldn't have been more evident this week in the Republican primaries, he can threaten and twist enough arms to make this happen.

In 2024 alone, Trump's 306 endorsements led to success in 96% of the primaries and 89% of the general elections. It should be that no Senate Republican can ignore the threat of a primary challenge if he or she stands in the way of the SAVE America Act.

According to Rule 3 of the Senate Republican Conference, it takes only five senators to force a meeting to call for Thune's replacement. That's not a hurdle, it's an invitation. In the privacy of a secret ballot, the "palace coup" needs just 27 votes to finalize the deed. Any replacement, witnessing Thune's political corpse, will understand his mandate: bring the SAVE America Act to the floor.

The filibuster is the next obstacle, and there are certainly not enough votes to abolish it, not to mention the precedent it would set for the Dems the second they retake

power (one hopes an event in the far distant future). But it's not necessary—we have reconciliation.

Reconciliation allows budget items to pass with a simple majority, provided they have a clear budgetary impact. There will certainly be pushback. How can election reform be framed as a budgetary item? However, using simple honesty, it shouldn't be hard.

The entire point of Democrat voter fraud is to install politicians who will ram through unbridled spending policies—including opening the borders to import millions of probable Democrat voters at an enormous cost to the American taxpayer. The Manhattan Institute calculates that the “average unlawful immigrant residing in the U.S. will cost the federal government \$225,000 more than he/she will pay in taxes over the next 30 years.”

If that isn't enough to justify reconciliation, I don't know what is. But that decision goes to the Senate Parliamentarian, Elizabeth MacDonough. She is technically a non-partisan, but she was appointed by the most notorious lying Dem in the history of the Senate, Harry Reid, which should tell you all you need to know. So don't count on the Parliamentarian to rule in favor of reconciliation here. Thankfully, we don't have to.

It's a little-known fact that the Parliamentarian's ruling is only advisory. The President of the Senate (that is, JD Vance) can—and, if he wants to be president in '28, will

ignore her advice and let the reconciliation process continue.

Note that overruling the Parliamentarian is not without precedent: in '49, Truman's vice president Barkley overruled the Parliamentarian, and Rockefeller did the same in '75.

Once Vance rules the SAVE America Act is in order, the Democrats would need 60 votes to sustain an appeal to overturn him. With only 47 seats, they'd be as feckless as Monty Python's Black Knight.

Mike Johnson will deliver the House, and then it's up to Trump—at any cost—to make sure he gets 50 of the 53 Republican senators to vote for the SAVE America Act with Vance being the deciding vote.

With almost the entire country united on voting reform—evidenced by the 80% consensus on key measures—and fueled by Trump's unrivaled political skills, the path forward is clear. By using the precise political maneuvering described here, getting this over the finish line to save our Republic is not merely plausible; it's inevitable.
